



UJA-Federation's Exodus Mission to Egypt and Israel

Relive the Passover journey that forged the Jewish people. | Saturday, March 26 – Monday, April 4, 2011

Join UJA-Federation of New York on a pre-Passover mission that will inspire, enlighten, and make for great conversation at next year's seder table. You'll visit the land where our forefathers marched from slavery to freedom.

Our journey will begin with three nights and four days in Egypt and then take us to Israel, where we will spend four nights and four days.

Itinerary Highlights

Egypt

- Explore Cairo, one of the largest cities in the Middle East, reflecting a vibrant mix of ancient and modern culture. Visit the National Museum; the Jewish Quarter, including its newly restored Moses Ben Maimon (Maimonides) synagogue; the Khan al-Khalili market; and more.
- Sail the Nile, the world's longest river, from which Moses was rescued as an infant.
- Visit the Great Sphinx and the Great Pyramid of Giza, the only one of the seven wonders of the ancient world still in existence.
- Uncover the mysteries of Luxor, with its astounding archaeological marvels, including the Temple of Karnak, the Valley of the Kings, the site of King Tut's tomb, and the Valley of the Queens.

Israel

- Tour the Old City of Jerusalem, with its ancient alleyways, colorful markets, and inspirational holy sites, including the Western Wall and its mystical tunnel.
- Visit Yad Vashem, the Jewish people's living memorial to the Holocaust.
- Experience Shabbat in Jerusalem, observed like nowhere else in the world.
- Participate in a model seder in the desert under the stars, and feel a connection to our forefathers who wandered there for 40 years.
- Choose from three customized itineraries: Yesterday (archaeology and the three Abrahamic faiths), Today (current hot-button political, ecological, and global issues), and Tomorrow (Arab-Israeli relations, the green movement, and technology).
