

CARES Act - Student Loans - Under the CARES Act stimulus package, federal student loans will automatically have their interest rates set to 0% for a period for six months and allow borrowers to pause payments. Importantly, this protection only applies to loans held by the Dept. of Education (Direct Ioan, ED-held FFEL Ioans, and ED-held Perkins Ioans). It will <u>not apply</u> for commercially held or school-held Perkins Ioans. Borrowers should log on to their student Ioan servicer's website to access their account for further information.
